Toy Story Land

ART

In a city as creative as Orlando, it's easy to find inspiration. The **Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art** in tree-lined Winter Park houses the world's most comprehensive collection by Louis Comfort Tiffany, while the **Cornell Fine Arts Museum at Rollins College** exhibits artwork from ancient times through modern day.

PLAY

Hit the links at more than 150 golf courses throughout the area. Stay at **Reunion Resort**, the only place in the world with signature greens from Arnold Palmer, Jack Nicklaus and Tom Watson. Elsewhere, **Falcon's Fire Golf Club**, designed by Rees Jones, is recognized as one of the best public golf courses in Orlando. Or visit **Shingle Creek Golf Club**, which sits along the headwaters of the Everglades, with fairways complemented by interconnecting waterways and dense thickets of oaks and pines.

RIDE

Orlando's theme parks have upped the ante with plenty of new experiences for kids of all ages. Take a ride with the "family" on **Fast & Furious—Supercharged** at Universal Studios Florida. Join Woody, Jessie and Buzz Lightyear in the 11-acre **Toy Story Land** at Disney's Hollywood Studios. Make a splash at SeaWorld Orlando's **Infinity Falls**. Or strap in and soar on **StarFlyer**, the world's tallest swing ride.

EAT

Through November 12, dine around the world at the **23rd Epcot International Food & Wine Festival**. Outside the parks, start with brunch at **Se7en Bites Bake Shop** in the Milk District; the biscuits and cheddar-chive grits are musts. Then choose from myriad toppings for a DIY sweet treat at **Little Blue Donut Co.** For dinner, make reservations at **The Rusty Spoon**, where chef and James Beard award nominee Kathleen Blake runs the show.

PLANNING A TRIP TO ORLANDO? It's safe to say you're not alone. After all, the Central Florida destination set a record of 72 million visitors last year, once again laying claim to being America's most-visited destination. While many travelers are drawn to the addictive theme parks—and who can blame them?—others find the world-class museums, recreational activities and dining just as appealing. And then there's the city's proximity to the beaches on the state's east and west coasts: Within about two hours or less, you can be searching for manatees at Canaveral National Seashore or lounging on the white sand of Clearwater Beach. Whatever your interests, Orlando lets you experience it all.
